eLearning Expectations

An eLearning option will also be offered at each of our schools as an alternative to in-person learning for families who prefer their student(s) continue learning remotely. A combination of synchronous and asynchronous instruction will be provided. Families will have the opportunity to reevaluate at the semester (after winter break)

- Consistent daily schedules with a combination of asynchronous and synchronous instruction
- Daily attendance for required synchronous instruction
- All synchronous instruction recorded
- Delivery of content through Google/Canvas LMS
- Grades

Parent Support for eLearning

- Familiarize yourself with your child's learning platform (Google Classroom, Canvas)
- Establish a regular routine and place for students to work on assignments and join (synchronous) online classes for example, a small desk or section of the kitchen table
- Ask questions to clarify assignments
- Notify your child's teacher if your student is unable to participate, just as you would report a normal absence and ensure that student is participating in learning on elearning days in order to be considered in attendance
- Partner with your child's teacher to support ongoing academic growth
- Attend either virtually or in person school information sessions regarding e-Learning
- Read and communicate regularly with your student's teacher to understand schedules, assignments and expectations
- Encourage physical activity
- Monitor student's time online

SEL curriculum can support teacher embedded or counselor delivered. At the K-5 level the lessons are on **a different platform** and can be delivered synchronously or asynchronously, as a full length, free-standing course, or as small 20-30 minute “modules” that are topically organized.

6-12 Edgenuity

- Academic content available to all students at 6-12

- SEL content available to all students at 6-12
SEL curriculum can support teacher embedded or counselor delivered. At the 6-12 level the lessons are on the same platform and can be delivered synchronously or asynchronously, as a full length, free-standing course, or as small 20-30 minute “modules” that are topically organized. Because the 6-12 curriculum is on the same platform as our core courses, you can also pull individual modules or lessons and include the SEL content in core subjects.

Edgenuity is the parent company that provides online content and full courses. The K-5 and 6-12 solutions operate on different platforms and different integrations but offer similar types of content.

Edgenuity content could be offered as stand alone interactive content with the ability for the teacher to assign lessons, monitor assessment data, and class progress. The content courses are also customizable so that a teacher can add his/her content as well.

Research and Reviews

- Schools in DCSD have used OdysseyWare online content solution for Credit Recovery and have moved to Edgenuity which is more comprehensive and can be utilized as credit recovery and/or as another online option for students to gain credit in electives, Advanced Placement, Career and Technical CTE courses and it also provides Social Emotional Courses and support to use in an extended online platform.
- We compared Florida Virtual and Edgenuity as two comparable platforms to provide a foundation for our eLearning and Hybrid courses to support all of our teachers in DCSD
- Ed Reports are from 2015-They reviewed only 6-8 Math. Because units do not reflect the coherence and focus from unit to unit, they are ranked low.

General **Sample** Weekly Instructional Expectations

The following sample is presented to offer ideas to help with planning and ideas for what a day might look like for students
